ACTIVITY 1

Encourage your class to pick a bird from the book and do a PMI on the bird's use of its vision to survive.

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ACTIVITY 2

Play Pictionary with 12 words in the book.

Divide the class into groups of 4 children.

The children take turns being the artist.

The first artist comes to the teacher and reads the first word then goes back to the group. The artist then draws the picture that describes the word. The rest of the group guess what it is. When they have guessed it correctly, another person from the group comes to the teacher for another word. The first group to guess all 12 words wins.
